Responsibilities:

- Engineer the processing to improve plant productivity and efficiency without compromising product quality and safety.
- Improve operation cost of existing operation by mean of productivity and efficiency improvement.
- To ensure all productions rejects are systematically analyzed and corrective action taken to minimize or eliminate reject.
- Support production failure investigation and recommend solution.
- Assist in investigation production on-line problem and provide solution.
- Analysis major customer complaints or non-conformances and execute corrective action.
- Assisting the production or technician team to conduct new product runs or trial runs and process improvement.
- Review validations and approved process.
- Responsible for the implementation and maintaining ISO 22000 or FSSC 22000, ISO 9001, MS 1480 systems and all department documentation.
- Ensure department compliance to the standards and regulatory requirement.
- Responsible for the plant Operations meeting all the company requirements and as well as ensure all communication on food safety are effectively executed and acted upon.
- Conduct periodic training and coaching to the production team member.
- Safeguarding occupational safety standards of the workforce.
- Ensure HACCP Critical Control Point CCP 3 are validated by the machine suppliers as schedule so that the machine detection integrity are not compromised.
- Ensure all OPRP programs are validated as schedule.
- Responsible to report food safety issues or concerns at the workplace to the superior.
- Responsible and accountable for food safety related task, able to prevent and catch deviations to the process that can impact on the safety of the products.
- To report problem with regards to FSMS to the superior immediately.
- Action must be taken immediately and effectively with appropriate oversight to ensure the right decisions are made in safeguarding food safety with regards to Food Safety Culture.
- Responsible to report problem(s) on Food Safety concern at any workplace or factory premises with regards to FSMS to superior immediately.
- To ensure Food Safety is everyone's job and responsibility.
- Prepare to work abnormal hours in short notice and when needed.
- Prepare daily or monthly report as requested.
- Any other duty assigned from time to time.
